You will meet with your child's form tutor for an overview and can also speak with individual subject teachers if you wish to discuss specific areas of learning or support. For Year 11 families, we will also share the November mock exam results with students during the event. A reminder that we will be offering free chips and curry sauce for all visitors.

Our **Family Support Worker**, Shahida, will be available to provide guidance and assistance across a range of areas, including family wellbeing, practical support and signposting to relevant services. In addition, we are pleased to welcome **Talk Consent**, who will deliver sessions for parents and carers on challenging misogyny and understanding the rules around consent, ensuring that the messages shared in school are reinforced at home.

We will also be joined by **Mind Birmingham's** Uroy, offering tailored support to our African Caribbean community, focusing on maintaining cultural identity and connecting families with further resources. Finally, Adam from **Ordinary Magic** will be on hand to provide advice and early intervention strategies to promote positive mental health.
