Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Year 11 exams and study leave arrangements

As we approach a pivotal point in our Year 11 students' academic journeys, I am writing to outline the arrangements for the upcoming examination period and study leave. The first examinations begin on Monday 16th March, with some students sitting assessments before the main exam series starts at the beginning of May. This is an important and often demanding time, and we appreciate your continued support in helping students prepare effectively.

Study Leave Arrangements

Study leave for all Year 11 students will begin on Monday 1st June 2026.

From this date:

- Students will only be collected by school transport if they have a morning (AM) exam.
- If students have an afternoon (PM) exam, they will be brought home by school transport after the exam.
- On days when students do not have an exam, they should remain at home and use the day for independent study and revision.

Please note the following important expectations:

- If a student has an AM exam, they must make their own way home once the exam has finished. They will not be permitted to remain on the school site afterwards.
- If a student has a PM exam, they should arrive at school for 12.30 pm, this will provide students time to have lunch and take part in a revision session before their exam start time.

Post Exam Activities

Once all examinations are complete, students will follow an activities timetable from Thursday 11th June 2026 to Wednesday 24th June 2026. More details will be provided nearer the time.

We are also pleased to share the dates for our Year 11 celebration events:

- Leavers' Meal: afternoon / evening of Thursday 25th June 2026
- Leavers' Assembly: morning of Friday 26th June 2026
